 - A NEW Resource Efficiency Club

 - Committed to making at least £245k of environmental cost savings between them

The ENVIBE Challenge!



- HOW?
 - Through targeted resource efficiency measures and monitoring:
 - Identify target areas for each business eg energy use, supply chain (raw materials), waste minimisation and diversion, water use etc
 - Collect baseline data, identify targets and actions
 - Implement and Monitor
 - But with help...

- Challenge Members receive:
 - Detailed utility management training
 - Consultancy support from ENVIBE Partners - at least three 1:1 meetings
 - Gadgets eg Meter Pod if need identified!
 - Regular Challenge meetings for members for sharing progress and learning
 - Dedicated Support of ENVIBE Challenge Co-ordinator
